Locatoin: This herb can be found in Columbia, Brazil and Venezuela. Description: The resin from this herb is used medicinally. Properties: Copaiba is known for being a relief aid for skin irritations. Also copaiba is known for aiding in the breaking down of mucus membranes.

Uses: Use copaiba to help treat eczema, arthritis, herpes, gonorrhea, syphilis or psoriasis. Doses: Copaiba can be found in oil form, tincture form and in shampoos.

Warnings: Do not ingest large quantities of copaiba. Use only pure forms of copaiba oil if you have allergic reactions to balsam of tolu.
